

Medical and Health Policy Annex during COVID-19 pandemic

First Aid – minor treatment

- A first aider will be present on site daily.
- The first aid room has been moved which allows for social distancing and a separation of students which may present with Covid19 symptoms
- This room has a separate exit, which will be used when directed to by the first aider.
- Two toilets have been allocated to first aid to allow the students to be separated according to their symptoms
- If this toilet has been used, it will then be closed and deep cleaned
- Where minor first aid treatment is required first aiders must ensure they wear gloves and a face covering when dealing with injuries as per the DFE recommendation on 12/05/20.
- If a temperature needs to be taken, there are temperature sensors on site to do this.
- Where possible (age and maturity of student) they will be asked to wipe away any blood or hold cold compresses etc.
- Records of injury and treatment will be recorded along with who administered first aid treatment.
- Hands to be washed after any contact.

First Aid – Life threatening

- In the event of a serious injury or incident call 999 immediately.
- In the case of an ambulance attending site, they will be directed to the west side gate to access the first aid room
- Students who require further treatment at the hospital will leave through that exit
- Face coverings and gloves will be worn when in close contact or dealing with bodily fluids
- In the event of CPR being required it is advised only chest compressions are given
- Hands to be washed after any contact

First Aid. Medication and intimate care

- First Aiders will always wear disposable gloves and a disposable apron when administering first aid procedures or intimate care.
- On each treatment, a new pair of gloves and apron is to be used and disposed of after use.
- A face covering will be worn if having to deliver close contact first aid as per the DFE recommendation on 01/06/20.
- Each first aider will be allocated their own face visor for their use only.
- Any dressings used to be double bagged and disposed of in the first aid secure bin. This bin will be emptied daily.
- Where any medications are administered students will be encouraged to self-administer. Otherwise staff will wear a face covering as per the DFE recommendation on 01/06/20.
